2075 and has since been efficiently running its academic programs.

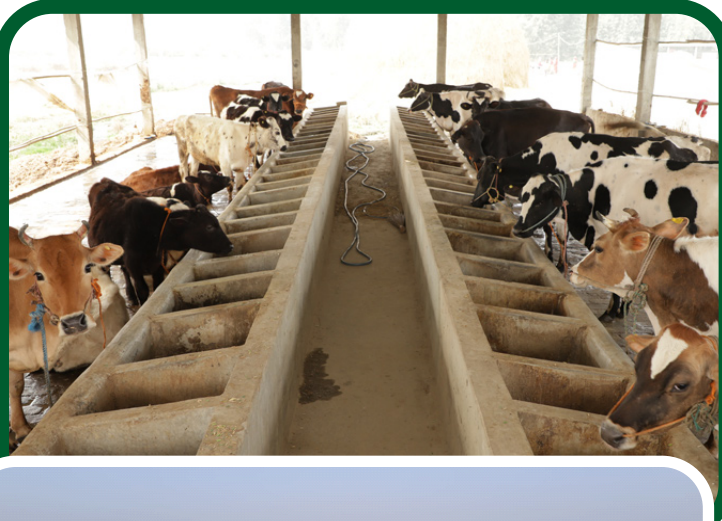
Salient Features

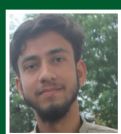
